



## FRANKLIN VETS REFERRAL SURGERY PRICE LIST

### Important note

**These prices are guidelines only. Every case is unique, and the initial diagnosis and treatment plan may alter in time and when the case arrives for surgery.**

A more accurate estimate range can be given after examination of x-rays and telephone discussion before referral, but a final estimate for treatment and aftercare will be given before surgery when the animal is presented to the surgery team.

Note that in almost all cases these prices include full blood workup and post-operative medications. In many cases (e.g. cruciates with tibial plateau levelling) x-rays will be needed before the surgery, but these are included in the estimates.

### Orthopaedic surgery

#### Fracture repair

Range of treatment options from intramedullary pinning to external skeletal fixation and locking and non-locking plating. Includes long bone, pelvic, mandibular fractures.

#### Joint surgery

- OCD shoulder \$2500-2700
- OCD stifle \$2500-2700
- Hock ligament reconstruction +/- arthrodesis \$2500-4000
- Pancarpal arthrodesis \$3500-4000
- Cruciate surgery (note that not all procedures are possible in all patients. Choice of which procedure is made after discussion with the client and obtaining diagnostic x-rays)
  - Extracapsular nylon \$2000-2500
  - TPLO \$4000-4600
  - TTO \$3700-3900
  - TTA (Ossability) \$3500-3700
  - Additional charges apply if other ligaments damaged or patellar luxation
- Multiligament stifle reconstruction
  - Dog \$4000-6000
  - Cat \$2000-3000
- Medial patella luxation small breed (wedge or block recession trochleoplasty with tibial tuberosity transposition, capsular release etc)
  - Single leg \$2000-2500
  - Bilateral MPL surgery on same day \$2700-3500
- Elbow dysplasia (note that large fragments of bone always have to be removed via arthrotomy even if the elbow has arthroscopy first)
  - Includes subtotal coronoidectomy, OCD flap removal and BURP \$2200-2600
- Open hip reduction and stabilization for luxation
  - Cat \$1800-2000
  - Dog \$2000-2200



- Forequarter or coxofemoral amputation
  - Cat \$1400-1600
  - Dog \$2000-2200
- Revisional surgery for non-union including bone grafting \$3000-5000

## Soft tissue surgery

- Total ear canal ablation with lateral bulla osteotomy \$3000-3500
  - Bilateral in one surgery \$4000-4500
- Cancer surgery including skin flaps, axial pattern flaps etc \$1500-3000
- Wound management \$1000-5000
- GDV \$3500-5000
- Intestinal surgery \$1800-4000
  - Gastrotomy medium size dog \$1800-2500
  - Enterectomy and anastomosis \$2200-3500
  - Prophylactic gastropexy \$1100-1300
  - Prophylactic gastropexy at time of speying \$1000-1100 in addition to spey price
- Thoracotomy \$2500-4000
- Perineal hernia repair \$2200-2500
  - Bilateral repair in one surgery \$3200-3500
- Perineal urethrostomy \$2000-2500
- Adrenalectomy \$2500-3000
- Nephrectomy \$2500-3000
- Diaphragmatic hernia repair \$2000-3000
- Soft palate resection and wedge resection nostrils \$1400-1500
- Abdominal organ biopsy via laparotomy \$2000-2500
- Partial/complete hepatic lobe resection for neoplasia \$3000-4000
- Anal sac removal \$1100-1200
- Salivary gland removal \$2000-2500
